- → Container
  - This container will house all the below contents
- → Flashlight(s)
  - We have handhelds and headlamps
- → Batteries
  - We have batteries for all flashlights, including batteries for everything else in the household
- → Candles
  - ◆ Tea lights, UCO candles, big, small
- → Candle holders
  - ◆ To contain the wax and prevent potential fires or damage
- → Lighters/Matches
  - ◆ The more lighters and matches, the better
- → NOAA Weather Radio/Crank Radio
  - ◆ Make sure the NOAA weather radio can take batteries and if you have a crank radio, that can be a nice backup
- → Lantern(s)
  - ◆ Candle lanterns, oil lanterns or lanterns that run on batteries

## Optional:

- → Pot/stove for off-grid cooking
  - ◆ This would be something like propane, please be responsible and use the propane outdoors or in a heavily ventilated area.

**Important notes**: we use our blackout kit as a way to stay organized. We house ALL of our batteries and ALL of our candles and ALL of our flashlights inside of this container. That way if we need batteries, we know exactly where to look. If we need candles we know where to look, and so on. This blackout kit is for bugging in purposes and is only to be used for light sources and information sources. It does not need to have any extra water or food or blankets because you're at home and those things can be stored properly elsewhere.
